Old Saybrook Land Trust Sponsors a New Nature Club for Children in Grades K-6

In recognition of the benefits of connecting children with nature and the fun of being outside, the Old Saybrook Land Trust is undertaking sponsorship of a new nature club, **OAK** (Outdoor Adventure Kids), for Old Saybrook's children in grades K-6.

OAK is a family oriented group which invites children to become naturalists and stewards of the earth while exploring the town's trail system.
